

## Tikkun v'Or Community Seder: Thursday, April 6 at 6 p.m.

To: All TVO members and friends

We're happy to announce that the TVO Board and Avodah Committee of TvO are organizing an in-person seder on Thursday, April 6 from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. for up to 60 TvO community members and their families and friends. Registration info is below.

Rabbi Shifrah will share ritual leadership with those in attendance. If you plan to attend in person, please consider whether you would be interested in participating in the ritual leadership or in reading a short passage.



Online attendance (which does *not* require registration) will be possible as well. Prior to the Seder, we will share a Zoom link for the Seder service (from approx. 6:00 to 7:00 p.m.) in the enews. Please note that all readings will be done by those in person at TvO; we will not ask for readers among Zoom attendees. (This decision reflects our hope to simplify audio requirements.)

### In-person seder specifics:

- **Masks optional:** In line with TvO's current policy, we will not require masks at this event.
- **Capacity:** We will cap registration for in-person attendance at 60. We plan to have 10 tables with 6 people each and will adjust as needed for a given reservation. If you register and know you want to have more than 6 people at your table, let us know so we can plan for that seating arrangement.
- **In-person meals:** For each in-person attendee, the meal will include an entree (select between chicken and eggplant), vegetarian matzoh ball soup, noodle kugel, and dessert. Ceremonial foods, including charoset and wine, will be provided.
- **No potluck items:** We do not need in-person attendees to provide meal items.
- **Cost:** We ask for **\$36 per attendee** to cover the cost of the meal and ceremonial foods. We do not want cost to deter your attendance. Scholarships will be available for those who need them. For those who want to assist others, we welcome additional donations to help ensure all can attend.
- Note that (unlike last year) we will not have meals available for to-go pickup this year.
