Dear Tikkun v'Or Members,

Warm wishes for a healthy and fulfilling year to all. We were so happy to see so many of you at High Holiday Services both in person and online. We found this year's services to be meaningful and inspiring, and we hope you did as well.

Tikkun v'Or is many things to many people. A center for learning, a spiritual home, a home for the holidays, a place to make and meet friends, a place to pursue justice. Our founders and past presidents have created something truly special at TvO. While we are deeply committed to sustaining and enriching that foundation, we need your help. As you pay your dues this year, we invite you to ask yourself **what is it worth to you to have a progressive Jewish Community in Ithaca that welcomes all?**

Last year, we promised that we would prioritize our core values with our spending while also taking care of our building - our spiritual home - which is aging and in need of repair. Over this past year, we replaced the worn, torn and stained carpeting with flooring that promises to be more sustainable. We repaired our Torah and Torah cover. We provided a variety of options for learning and praying together. We updated some of our technology. We invested in our educators. We hired experts to help keep us safe. Unfortunately, for the last few years, our expenses have been greater than our income.

In the coming year, there is more to be done. Inflation and our personnel costs have been increasing. We need to continue with repairs to our building. We are currently working to assess our security needs and will be applying for grant funding to help with those costs. In the name of inclusivity, we would like to continue with hybrid events but our current AV equipment is woefully inadequate. We need to replenish our savings to plan for expenses that we know are coming in the near future. And while the Board will make fundraising a top priority in the coming year, we now need your financial support more than ever.

May it be a Shana Tova for all. We look forward to your continued membership and participation.

Tikkun v'Or Member Contributions: Three-Part Financial Structure

Congregation Tikkun v'Or raises the funds we need through **dues**, **gifts** and **fees**. Our financial structure is inspired by traditional Jewish values of fairness, dignity, inclusivity and generosity. *Finances should never be a barrier to Tikkun v'Or membership. However, to ensure the long-term viability of the temple, we ask that you please think seriously about your level of support and follow the suggested guideline to the best of your ability. Dues and gifts are all fully tax deductible.*

Dues are assessed in two parts: the *hetzi-shekel* (half-shekel) portion, and a portion determined by an income-based sliding scale.

The *hetzi-shekel* portion (\$90 per household) is intended to symbolize the equality of all members in the community, regardless of income. The concept derives from the story told in the book of Exodus that Moses and Aaron collected a half-shekel from each of the Israelites as their first contribution toward building the sanctuary.

The **income-based ("fair share") dues*** are 1.6% of household income from all sources. The sliding scale dues structure reflects our community's commitment to justice and fairness. These are guidelines. Please pay as your circumstances allow. As an example, if your gross income is \$40,000 X 0.016=\$640 Suggested "Fair Share" Dues Payment.

Our projected budget depends on most members *self-assessing* and paying at the 1.6% level. However, if life circumstances affect your ability to pay dues at the target level or at the times indicated, please self-assess at a lower level or adjust the payment schedule as needed. You can also contact us, Laurie Willick and Sue Merkel (presidents_22@tikkunvor.org), to discuss your dues at any time. *Finances should never be a barrier to Tikkun v'Or membership*.

Gifts: The *hetzi-shekel* and income-based dues (described above) comprise about 66% of our budget. Thus, Tikkun v'Or also relies on **nediv lev**, which translates as "generosity" or "giving from the heart". This phrase comes from the book of Exodus where it is told that the Israelites offered materials for building the sanctuary with a "willing heart," each contributing according to their ability. **Nediv lev** contributions to Tikkun v'Or account for approximately 15% of yearly revenue and are requested during our annual spring fundraising campaign.

Fees for our Jewish Learning Experiences and b'mitzvah program help cover the costs of these programs, but do not fully sustain the school. If school fees pose a financial hardship, please be in touch with us, Laurie Willick and Sue Merkel (presidents_22@tikkunvor.org), to discuss. Note that first-year families with students in grades K-5 are given the option of paying a slightly higher school fee that includes temple membership (*i.e.*, if this option is chosen, other temple membership dues are waived for that first year).
